GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS DURING MOKSHA 2017

1. During Moksha 2017, it is mandatory for all the students of the Institute to carry their I Cards round the clock in the Institute. No student of the Institute will be allowed to be present at the venue of the Fest without having an I Card of the Institute. Those students who are not having I Cards of the Institute at present are advised to get the same prepared latest by 24.03.2017.
2. It is also compulsory for the students/participants of other Institute(s) to carry their I Cards of concerned University/Institute at all times in the Institute during the fest days. Any student/participant of any other University/Institute will not be permitted to enter in the Institute's Campus without holding an I Card of concerned University/Institute. They will have to show the same on demand.
3. Consumption of alcohol, drugs and other prohibited items is strictly banned in the Institute. Strict disciplinary action including expulsion from the Institute will be taken against any student found in possession of the same or consuming them during Moksha 2017.
4. All students/participants are advised to use maximum public transport and desist from bringing private vehicles in the Institute since Institute is not providing any parking facility in the Institute.
5. The Moksha Student Coordinator/Chief Convener of the Institute are directed to bring the same into notice of all students of the Institute/participants for strict compliance of the above mentioned points at S.No.1 to 4.
6. All hostellers of the Institute are strictly directed to not to allow any person in their allotted rooms without obtaining prior permission of the Competent Authority. In case any prohibited item is found in their allotted rooms, then in that case concerned hosteller will only be responsible, whatsoever be the reasons.
7. All hostellers of the Institute are directed to carry their Hostel I Cards of the Institute at all times during their presence in the hostels of the Institute.
8. Bag(s) of any student/hosteller may be checked by Security staff/Moksha Volunteers at any times. Further, Students/hostellers will have to show their I Cards on demand.
9. All the concerned student volunteers of Moksha 2017 are directed to perform their assigned duties and responsibilities during Moksha 2017 meticulously and will inform the Faculty Incharge Moksha 2017 prior taking any leave during Moksha 2017.

Further since these Student Volunteers carry special responsibilities for peaceful organization of this mega event, therefore, if, in case any Moksha student volunteer is found involved in any indisciplinary activity in the Institute during Moksha 2017, most severe action including expulsion from the Institute may be taken against him.
